Information Clause – Conference Participant Registration

Information on the processing of personal data for Participants of the “CEE Hydromet 2026” Conference

In connection with the implementation of the requirements of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46/EC, hereinafter referred to as the “GDPR”, the Controller informs you about the rules for the processing of your personal data and the rights you have in relation to such processing.

1. Details of the personal data Controller

3. Purposes and legal basis for the processing of personal data

3.1. Personal data of Participants of the “CEE Hydromet 2026” Conference, held on 18–19 November 2026 at the University Library, ul. Fryderyka Joliot-Curie 12, 50-383 Wrocław, Poland, hereinafter referred to as the “Conference”, including: first name and surname, academic degree or title, name of the represented institution, e-mail address, telephone number, information on the intention to participate as a speaker, presentation title, abstract, affiliation and other data provided by the Participant in connection with Registration or submission of a presentation, will be processed for the following purposes and on the following legal bases:

- a) for the purpose of handling Registration, organising the Conference and contacting the Participant — pursuant to Article 6(1)(b) GDPR;



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- b) for the purpose of handling speaker submissions, including accepting and evaluating abstracts and contacting the Participant regarding the submitted presentation — pursuant to Article 6(1)(b) GDPR and Article 6(1)(f) GDPR, i.e. the legitimate interest of the Controller consisting in preparing the Conference programme and ensuring its appropriate substantive quality;
- c) for the purpose of fulfilling legal obligations imposed on the Controller, where such obligations arise — pursuant to Article 6(1)(c) GDPR;
- d) for the purpose of pursuing or defending against claims, keeping statistics, assessing the quality of the Conference and ensuring the proper organisation of the event — pursuant to Article 6(1)(f) GDPR, i.e. the legitimate interest of the Controller;
- e) for the purpose of sending information about future events, activities or initiatives related to the Conference, if the Participant gives separate consent — pursuant to Article 6(1)(a) GDPR.

3.2. The image of the Participant recorded as part of a general report from the Conference will be processed pursuant to Article 6(1)(f) GDPR, i.e. the legitimate interest of the Controller consisting in documenting the Conference, providing information about it, and promoting the Conference and the activities of the Organiser. In the case of individual statements, interviews, posed photographs or recordings in which the Participant is the main subject of the recording, personal data will be processed on the basis of the Participant's separate consent, i.e. Article 6(1)(a) GDPR.

4. Source of personal data

Participants' personal data are obtained from the Registration Form, correspondence conducted with the Organiser and materials provided by the Participant in connection with Registration or the submission of a presentation.

5. Recipients of personal data

5.1. In connection with the processing of personal data for the purposes specified in Section 3, your personal data may be disclosed to entities supporting the Controller in organising the Conference, in particular providers of registration systems, IT services, hosting, e-mail services, website maintenance services, as well as persons cooperating in the organisation of the Conference.



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5.2. In the case of Participants who declare their intention to participate in the Conference as speakers, personal data, including data contained in the presentation submission, presentation title and abstract, may be disclosed to members of the Scientific Council to the extent necessary to evaluate the submission and decide whether to include the presentation in the Conference programme.

5.3. In the case of publication of photographic, audiovisual or audio materials from the Conference, recipients of personal data may include users of the Conference website, the Organiser's website and the Organiser's or Conference's social media profiles.

5.4. Personal data may also be disclosed to entities authorised to receive them under applicable law.

6. Personal data retention period

6.1. Your personal data will be processed for the period necessary to organise and conduct the Conference, handle Registration, maintain organisational contact, handle any speaker submissions and archive documentation for the period required by law or necessary to protect the legitimate interests of the Controller.

6.2. Personal data processed for the purpose of pursuing or defending against claims will be stored for the limitation period of any potential claims resulting from applicable law.

6.3. Personal data processed on the basis of consent, in particular for the purpose of sending information about future events, activities or initiatives related to the Conference, will be processed until the consent is withdrawn. Withdrawal of consent does not affect the lawfulness of processing carried out before its withdrawal.

6.4. Photographic, audiovisual or audio materials documenting the course of the Conference may be stored for the period during which documentation, information, promotional and archival activities related to the Conference and the activities of the Organiser are carried out, but no longer than for the period in which such materials remain useful for the indicated purposes, unless applicable law or an objection submitted by the Participant justifies earlier restriction of their use.

7. Rights of the data subject



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You have the right to:

- a) withdraw consent, where processing is based on consent — withdrawal of consent does not affect the lawfulness of processing carried out on the basis of consent before its withdrawal;
- b) access your personal data, including the right to obtain a copy of such data;
- c) rectify inaccurate personal data;
- d) erase personal data processed on the basis of your consent;
- e) restrict the processing of personal data;
- f) object to the processing of personal data;
- g) lodge a complaint with the President of the Personal Data Protection Office (address: Urząd Ochrony Danych Osobowych, ul. Stawki 2, 00-193 Warsaw, Poland), if you believe that the processing of your personal data violates the provisions of the GDPR.

8. Voluntary provision of personal data

8.1. Providing your personal data is voluntary; however, it is necessary in order to submit the Conference Registration Form. Failure to provide the data prevents acceptance of the Registration Form. Providing false data may result in liability under applicable law.

8.2. Where processing is based on consent, you have the right to withdraw your consent to the collection and processing of your personal data at any time. Withdrawal of consent does not affect the lawfulness of processing carried out on the basis of consent before its withdrawal.
