Exhibitor Regulations for the Conference entitled “CEE Hydromet 2026”

§ 1. GENERAL PROVISIONS

1. These Regulations define the terms and conditions of participation in the 2nd edition of the Conference entitled CEE Hydromet 2026 as an Exhibitor. The event is organised by Fundacja Spacerowa 7, with its registered office at ul. Spacerowa 7, 57-540 Łądek-Zdrój, Poland, NIP: 8811489269, e-mail address: info@ceehydromet.org.
2. The Conference will take place on 18–19 November 2026 at the University Library, ul. Fryderyka Joliot-Curie 12, 50-383 Wrocław, Poland.
3. Participation in the Conference as an Exhibitor is paid and requires prior registration and acceptance by the Organiser.
4. The Privacy Policy defines the manner in which personal data are processed and constitutes Appendix No. 1 to these Regulations.
5. These Regulations apply to English-speaking Exhibitors participating in the Conference as Exhibitors.

§ 2. DEFINITIONS

For the purposes of these Regulations, the following definitions apply:

- a) Regulations – this document containing the rules and conditions of participation in the Conference, available on the website at: <https://ceehydromet.org/>
- b) Organiser – Fundacja Spacerowa 7, with its registered office in Łądek-Zdrój, Poland, ul. Spacerowa 7, 57-540 Łądek-Zdrój, NIP: 8811489269.
- c) Conference – the Conference entitled CEE Hydromet 2026, organised by the Organiser and held at the University Library, ul. Fryderyka Joliot-Curie 12, 50-383 Wrocław, Poland.
- d) Exhibitor Registration – the process of registering participation in the Conference as an Exhibitor, carried out via the Registration Form, including completion of the Registration Form, acceptance of the Regulations and the Privacy Policy, and subsequently carrying out further steps communicated to the Exhibitor by the Organiser electronically, including providing data required to issue a pro forma invoice and paying the exhibitor fee after positive verification of the registration.

- e) Registration Form – the form through which Registration is carried out, available on the website.
- f) Confirmation of Registration – a message sent by the Organiser to the e-mail address provided during the Registration process, confirming receipt or status of the registration.
- g) Exhibitor – an entity that registers to participate in the Conference as an exhibitor and whose registration has been accepted by the Organiser.
- h) Exhibition Space – a standard exhibition space measuring 2 × 2 m, with a basic electrical connection, unless the Organiser indicates otherwise.

§ 3. REGISTRATION PROCEDURE

1. Participation in the Conference as an Exhibitor requires Registration via the Registration Form available on the Conference website at: <https://ceehydromet.org/> or at another address indicated by the Organiser.
2. In the Registration Form, the Exhibitor provides the required data, indicates the intention to participate in the Conference as an Exhibitor, and accepts the Regulations and the Privacy Policy.
3. Each person representing the Exhibitor who will be present during the Conference is required to register via the Registration Form, in accordance with the rules indicated by the Organiser.
4. After the Form has been submitted, the registration is subject to verification by the Organiser, in particular in terms of the availability of exhibition spaces and the compatibility of the Exhibitor's profile with the nature of the Conference.
5. After positive verification of the registration, the Organiser sends the Exhibitor, electronically, information on acceptance of the registration and further organisational instructions, including the next steps related to participation in the Conference, a request to provide the data necessary to issue a pro forma invoice, and payment information.
6. Final confirmation of participation in the Conference as an Exhibitor is conditional upon the Exhibitor completing the further steps indicated by the Organiser and paying the exhibitor fee in accordance with § 4 of these Regulations, unless the Organiser indicates another method of confirming Registration.
7. The registration deadline expires on the date indicated by the Organiser. After this deadline, registrations are possible only upon individual agreement with the Organiser and subject to availability of places.

§ 4. PAYMENTS

1. The fee for participation in the Conference as an Exhibitor is EUR 1,200.00 net and will be increased by applicable tax in accordance with applicable regulations.
2. After positive verification of the registration, the Organiser issues a pro forma invoice based on the data provided by the Exhibitor and sends it electronically.
3. The Exhibitor makes payment to the bank account indicated by the Organiser, within the deadline specified on the pro forma invoice or in the information provided by the Organiser.
4. After the fee has been credited, the Organiser confirms the Exhibitor's participation in the Conference and issues an invoice in accordance with applicable regulations.
5. Failure to credit the fee within the required deadline may result in cancellation of the Exhibitor's registration.
6. Accommodation, transport and other logistical costs related to participation in the Conference shall be covered by the Exhibitor on its own.
7. If the Exhibitor withdraws from participation in the Conference, the fee paid is non-refundable, unless the Organiser decides otherwise. A refund of the fee is possible in particular if the Organiser withdraws from the participation of a given Exhibitor for reasons attributable to the Organiser.

§5. EXHIBITION STAND AND PARTICIPATION IN THE CONFERENCE PROGRAMME

1. Each Exhibitor is assigned a standard exhibition space measuring 2 × 2 m with a basic electrical connection, unless the Organiser agrees different terms with the Exhibitor.
2. The Exhibitor may not make all or part of the assigned space available to other entities without the prior consent of the Organiser.
3. The Exhibitor is responsible for preparing and arranging its own stand, including its equipment and manner of presentation.
4. All promotional materials and devices presented at the stand must comply with applicable law and good practice and must not infringe the rights of third parties.
5. Installation of the exhibition may take place only at the time and place indicated by the Organiser.

6. The Organiser reserves the right to remove or request modification of exhibition or advertising elements that the Organiser considers inconsistent with the nature of the Conference, safety rules or these Regulations.
7. All promotional materials distributed to participants must come directly from the Exhibitor and may be distributed only within the assigned space, unless the Organiser agrees to another form of distribution.
8. The Exhibitor is obliged to dismantle the stand and restore the exhibition space to its original condition after the end of the Conference, in accordance with the instructions of the Organiser or the venue where the Conference is held.
9. The Exhibitor has the right to submit one presentation during the Conference, after prior submission of the presentation topic electronically to info@ceehydromet.org or in another manner indicated by the Organiser. The submission should include the title, first name and surname of the speaker, and a short abstract. The presentation will be included in the programme only after acceptance by the Organiser, who reserves the right to reject the submission or propose modification of the topic.

§6. LIABILITY

1. The Exhibitor bears full responsibility for the materials, devices, stand equipment presented by it, and for all actions of the Exhibitor and its representatives during the Conference.
2. The Organiser shall not be liable for property damage, loss of property, disappearance or destruction of advertising materials, equipment or other items belonging to the Exhibitor, unless the damage was caused solely by the fault of the Organiser.
3. The Organiser shall not be liable for damage resulting from force majeure, including random events, administrative decisions, technical failures, power outages or other events beyond the Organiser's control.
4. The Exhibitor is obliged to comply with applicable laws, occupational health and safety regulations, the rules applicable at the venue where the Conference is held, and all guidelines of the Organiser during the Conference.
5. The Exhibitor shall be liable for any damage caused on the premises of the conference venue through the fault of the Exhibitor or its representatives.

§7. FINAL PROVISIONS

1. The Organiser makes the content of these Regulations available before Exhibitor Registration.
2. The Organiser reserves the right to amend these Regulations.
3. The amended Regulations apply to Exhibitors who completed Registration after the changes were published or who accepted the amended content of the Regulations.
4. The number of places for participation in the Conference as an Exhibitor is limited. Participation in the Conference is determined by the order of registrations and acceptance of the registration by the Organiser.
5. In matters not regulated by these Regulations, the provisions of the Civil Code shall apply accordingly.
6. If any provision of these Regulations is amended or invalidated by a final court judgment, the remaining provisions shall remain in force.
7. Any disputes between the Organiser and the Exhibitor shall first be resolved amicably, and if no agreement is reached, by the court competent in accordance with applicable law.
8. The Privacy Policy constitutes an integral part of these Regulations. Amendments to the Privacy Policy shall be subject, as appropriate, to the provisions concerning amendments to these Regulations.
