



CEE HYDROMET CONFERENCE 2026

Participation Regulations for the Conference entitled “CEE Hydromet 2026”

§ 1. GENERAL PROVISIONS

1. These Regulations define the terms and conditions of participation in the Conference entitled CEE Hydromet 2026, organised by Fundacja Spacerowa 7, with its registered office at ul. Spacerowa 7, 57-540 Łądek-Zdrój, Poland, NIP: 8811489269, e-mail address: info@ceehydromet.org.
2. The Conference will take place on 18-19 November 2026 at the University Library, ul. Fryderyka Joliot-Curie 12, 50-383 Wrocław, Poland.
3. Privacy Policy – sets out the rules for the processing of personal data. The Privacy Policy constitutes Appendix No. 1 to the Terms and Conditions and is available at <https://ceehydromet.org/>

§ 2. DEFINITIONS

For the purposes of these Regulations, the following definitions apply:

- a) Regulations – this document containing the rules and conditions of participation in the Conference, available on the website at: <https://ceehydromet.org/>
- b) Organiser – Fundacja Spacerowa 7, with its registered office in Łądek-Zdrój, Poland, ul. Spacerowa 7, 57-540 Łądek-Zdrój, NIP: 8811489269.
- c) Conference – the Conference entitled CEE Hydromet 2026, organised by the Organiser and held at the University Library, ul. Fryderyka Joliot-Curie 12, 50-383 Wrocław, Poland.
- d) Participant Registration – the submission to the Organiser of a given natural person’s intention to participate in the Conference by completing the Registration Form.
- e) Registration Form – the form through which Participant Registration is carried out, available on the website.
- f) Confirmation of Registration – a message sent by the Organiser to the e-mail address provided by the Participant during the Registration process, confirming the Registration.
- g) Participant – a natural person indicated in the Registration Form.



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§ 3. CONDITIONS OF PARTICIPATION

1. Participation in the Conference requires Registration via the Registration Form available on the Conference website at: <https://ceehydromet.org/>
2. Participation in the Conference is free of charge for Participants; however, the Organiser reserves the right to refuse a registration if no places are available or if the Registration conditions are not met.
3. In order to complete Registration, the Participant should complete and submit the Registration Form on the website.
4. Participant Registration is confirmed after the Registration Form has been completed and the Participant has received confirmation of registration from the Organiser, unless the Organiser indicates another method of confirming Registration.
5. Data provided in the Registration Form are processed by the Organiser for the purpose of handling Registration, organising the Conference and contacting the Participant, in accordance with the Privacy Policy constituting Appendix No. 1 to these Regulations.
6. The Participant covers the costs of accommodation and travel on their own.
7. The deadline for submitting Conference participation registrations expires on the date indicated by the Organiser. After this deadline, registration will be possible in person at the conference reception during the Conference, subject to availability of places.

§ 4. COMPLAINTS

1. Any complaints from Participants concerning participation in the Conference or its organisation should be submitted to the Organiser in writing, by e-mail to: info@ceehydromet.org or to the Organiser's registered office address.
2. A complaint should include: the first name and surname of the person submitting the complaint, correspondence address or e-mail address, telephone number, description of the subject of the complaint, date of the event and indication of the factual circumstances justifying the complaint.
3. Complaints may be submitted within 14 days from the end of the Conference. This deadline does not limit the Participant's rights arising from mandatory provisions of law.



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4. The Organiser will review the complaint within 14 business days from the date of its receipt and will provide its position to the person submitting the complaint in the same form in which the complaint was submitted, unless the person submitting the complaint indicates another form of contact.

§5. OBLIGATIONS OF PARTICIPANTS

1. The Participant is obliged to familiarise themselves with these Regulations.

§6. LIABILITY

1. The Organiser declares that the content provided during the Conference is for educational purposes only. The Organiser shall not be liable for any damage suffered by Participants or third parties in connection with or as a result of the use by Participants of information, knowledge or skills obtained during the Conference.
2. If the Conference does not take place for reasons solely attributable to the Organiser, the Organiser will immediately inform the Participant of this fact. The Organiser shall not be liable for accommodation, travel or any other costs incurred by the Participant in connection with their planned participation in the Conference.
3. The Organiser reserves the right to make changes to the Conference programme, change speakers, and cancel the Conference in the event of unforeseen circumstances beyond the Organiser's control. In the event of cancellation of the Conference, registered Participants will be informed of this fact.

§ 7. RULES FOR THE USE OF IMAGE, VOICE AND STATEMENTS

1. The Organiser informs that the course of the Conference may be recorded in the form of photographs, audiovisual and/or audio recordings, in particular for the purposes of documentation, information, promotion and archiving of the Conference and the Organiser's activities.
2. The recording referred to in section 1 may cover the general course of the Conference, including shots of conference rooms, the audience, common areas, presentations, panel discussions, exhibition stands and other elements of the event.
3. Materials containing the image of Participants may be used and disseminated by the Organiser, in accordance with the Privacy Policy, for documentation, information and promotional purposes, in particular through publication on the



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Conference website, the Organiser's website, social media, and in informational, promotional and Conference summary materials.

4. The Participant acknowledges that their image may be recorded as part of a larger whole, in particular as part of the audience, a group of participants, the background of the event or a general report from the Conference.
5. In the case of individual statements, interviews, posed photographs, recordings or other materials in which the Participant is the main subject of the recording, the Organiser may ask the Participant to give separate consent to the use of their image, voice or statement.
6. A Participant who does not consent to the individual recording of their image should inform the Organiser before a photograph or recording is made or before giving a statement.
7. Detailed information on the processing of personal data, including the Participant's image, is provided in the Privacy Policy constituting Appendix No. 1 to these Regulations.

§8. FINAL PROVISIONS

1. The Organiser makes the content of these Regulations available before Registration.
2. The Organiser reserves the right to amend these Regulations.
3. The amended Regulations apply to Participants who completed Registration after the changes were published or who accepted the amended content of the Regulations.
4. The number of places for participation in the Conference is limited. Participation in the Conference is determined by the order of registrations.
5. The Organiser reserves the right to exclude from participation in the Conference any Participants who violate any provisions of these Regulations, in particular those who:
 - a) undertake actions contrary to law, good practice or the legitimate interests of third parties;
 - b) undertake actions aimed at circumventing, or indicating an attempt to circumvent, the Regulations or the rules of the Conference;
 - c) undertake actions that infringe the legitimate interests of the Organiser or harm its image.



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6. In matters not regulated by these Regulations, the provisions of the Civil Code shall apply accordingly.
7. If any provision of these Regulations is amended or invalidated by a final court judgment, the remaining provisions shall remain in force.
8. Any disputes between the Organiser and the Participant shall first be resolved amicably, and if no agreement is reached, by the court competent in accordance with applicable law.
9. The Organiser shall not be liable for Participants' belongings that may be lost, damaged or stolen during the Conference.
10. The Privacy Policy constitutes an integral part of these Regulations. Amendments to the Privacy Policy shall be subject, as appropriate, to the provisions concerning amendments to these Regulations.
